For over forty years, auto no-fault has served as the auto insurance model in the State of Michigan. This policy has resulted in a lifetime of care for people who are injured in automobile accidents. According to the CDC, over 6,300 people visit emergency rooms every day as a result of an automobile accident. With the proper care, they are able to recover from these often catastrophic events in a timely and affordable fashion.

The NeuroTrauma Association has been working tirelessly to bring the Michigan model for no-fault auto insurance to other states.
